

Spring 2016 District 2 Interleague Rules

Minor “B” Pitch Softball

The Official Regulations and playing Rules of Little League Softball, Minor Division will be followed by the Leagues listed below involved in Interleague Play for the Minor Softball Division. The following Interleague Rules will also be in effect along with the Little League Regulations and Rules.

- 1) All games will be one and one-half (1 ½) hours in length, from the scheduled start time. All play will cease two (2) hours from the scheduled start time.
- 2) All games will consist of MACHINE/ADULT pitch. After seven pitches by machine or adult pitcher without a ball hit for a hit or out, the batter will be called out. If a player fouls the seventh pitch, they continue to bat until they either hit the ball fair or miss the pitch. All players will bat in a continuous batting order.
- 3) The catcher will stand behind the plate in gear but does not need to squat down in regulation catching position. One player will stand by the machine or adult pitcher and play the pitchers position. One offensive coach will operate the machine or pitch to batters.
- 4) There is a five (5) run limit per inning. All play will cease after the play ends when the fifth (5th) run has scored.
- 5) The Host League shall supply two (2) new games balls. The Visiting Team shall supply two (2) serviceable game balls.
- 6) The team coaches shall umpire their own game.

These Interleague Rules will go into effect immediately.
